## Assignment:

Create a travel brochure that include brief information and/or pictures on the following topics:

- Fast Facts: capital, population, official language, official name, form of government, etc.
- Land forms/regions
- Provinces/major cities (include a map of the country)
- History
- Government
- Art/Architecture/Culture/Customs/Holidays/Wildlife
- A special feature of the country (Example: Peru: Machu Picchu, Lake Titicaca, or Cusco)

Include a brief description of **one** current issue facing your country, for example (Peru):

- Pollution/e-waste
- Poverty
- Tourism and effect on Inca ruins
- Employment
- Human rights
- Climate change
